Madison County USBC BA meeting minutes from September 24, 2017

The meeting started with Narita Rose talking about designs for the new association shirts. She suggested using the EKU colors of maroon and white for the color scheme. The shirts will cost \$46 per shirt and can have any design we want. Jenny Norman suggested we each director pay \$20 and the association pay the rest for the shirts. He told the members if anyone is interested in running for a state office to let him know. He said the KSBA will need an association manager since Pete Atkinson is stepping down. He said he would keep us informed on what is going on with the state association. Harvey said we don't make a lot of money off the tournament itself and said the state usually loses money. He said we will make money off of the brackets, 50/50 pot and the ball raffle. Mark Rogers will take care of the ball raffle. He asked everyone to show up if they can to help out with the tournament. Beverly Shearer asked where to get the entry forms for the tournament. Harvey said the forms are on the state website and Lewis said it will be posted on our website. Harvey said we will skip the association meeting at the state senior tournament and hold our next meeting after the Turkey Shootout Tournament. Jelemia Sanders asked about the house not using the foul lights. Harvey said he doesn't see them being used because of the cost to fix them but said should be addressed by the leagues. David Norman said opposing teams can call fouls. Keeley Gadd asked about working the Turkey Shootout. Harvey said to just show up and bowl and he explained how the tournament works. The members also discussed resetting the association committees now that we have a merged association. Lewis will send out an email so the board members can chose what committees they are interested in. Meeting adjourned.
